

# 2nd Grade News

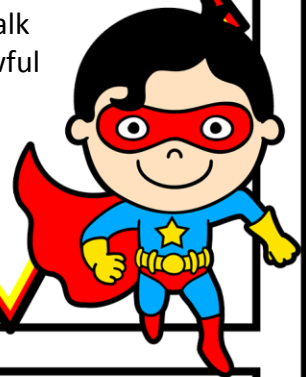
