Science: What Causes Loud & Soft Sounds

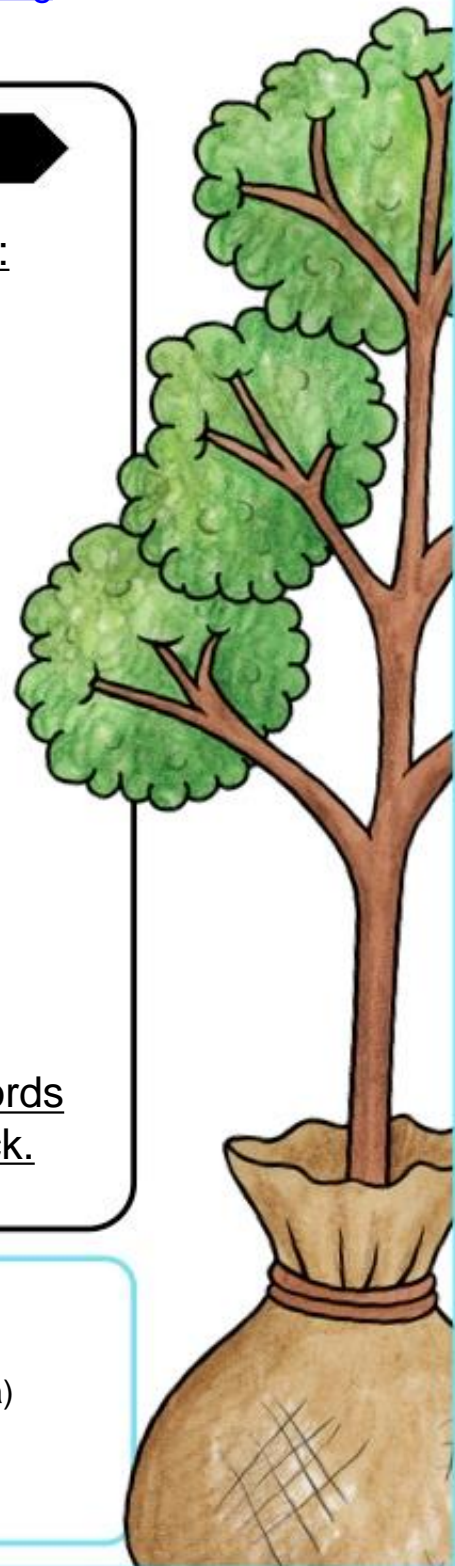
