What we will be working on January 7-11, 2019:

ELA: Saxon Phonics letter Uu and Zz: distinguish between sounds that are the same and those that are different/ identify the consonant sound and short vowel sound (practice at home: **L, O, G, H, T, P, A, N, M, I, twin consonants ll,ss, S, F, R, K, B, U,Z** (sound and recognition)

Reading: Read alouds : books about Winter

Sight words: *practice at home: I, like, the, and, we, end, a, to, see, got, hot, an, not, on, am, him, in, it, you, what, come, me, from, away, with, my

Grammar: Work with sentence parts: verbs
